AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF STANDARDS OF CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 38G of chapter 71
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of
3 chapter 278 of the acts of 1951, is hereby amended
4 by adding at the end the words: — ; provided, never-
5 theless, that no requirements respecting hours of
6 credit in courses affecting the above-mentioned persons
7 shall become effective prior to three years subsequent
8 to their promulgation by said board, — so as to read
9 as follows:— The board of education, hereinafter
10 referred to as the board, shall grant certificates upon
11 application to teachers, principals, supervisors, direc-
12 tors, superintendents and assistant superintendents
13 of schools who meet the requirements established by
14 said board; provided, nevertheless, that no require-
15 ments respecting hours of credit in courses affecting
16 the above-mentioned persons shall become effective
17 prior to three years subsequent to their promulgation
18 by said board.
