AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO REGULATE THE BUSINESS OF GAS FITTING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 21 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (17), as
3 most recently amended by chapter 352 of the acts of
4 1951, the following paragraph: —

5 (18) For regulating the inspection, materials, con-
6 struction, installation, alteration or use of pipes,
7 fittings and fixtures through which gas is supplied
8 within buildings and other structures.
