## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN INFORMATION TO BE CONTAINED  
ON COPY OF INDICTMENT OF PERSONS COMMITTED TO PENAL  
INSTITUTIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 279 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing out section 35, as amended by section 103 of chapter 770 of  
3 the acts of 1955, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 section: —

5 *Section 35.* When a person is committed to any correctional  
6 institution of the commonwealth or to any other public penal  
7 institution, on conviction of felony, the clerk of the court shall,  
8 without charge, transmit with the mittimus an attested copy of  
9 the complaint or indictment and the statutory section number  
10 and chapter under which such person was convicted, and the  
11 names and addresses of the witnesses who testified for and  
12 against such person at the trial, together with a record contain-  
13 ing the names and addresses of the presiding justice, district  
14 attorney and of the attorney for the defendant.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be admitted to or separated from the Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by the following Rule, to-wit:
