AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ADVANCEMENT OF FUNDS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN FURTHERANCE OF AGREEMENTS WITH RAILROAD CORPORATIONS WHICH PROVIDE FOR RELOCATION OR OTHER WORK ON PROPERTY OF SUCH CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby au-
2 thorized to enter into agreements with railroad corporations for
3 the purpose of performing any work which may be necessary in
4 connection with the construction of highways, roads, bridges and
5 other public works undertaken by said department whenever
6 such construction or work would entail relocation, alteration or
7 other work on the tracks, bridges or other property of such
8 corporation. Said agreements may provide for the monthly
9 advancement of funds to such corporations covering the cost of
10 such work whenever it appears that otherwise delay would re-
11 sult in the reasonable progress of such work so as to obstruct
12 and impede the construction of public highways and disrupt the
13 free flow of public transportation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTERS ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE AND ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE OF THE ACTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH, AND TO REPEAL AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE COMMONWEALTH, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTERS ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE AND ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE OF THE ACTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in their annual session, at the City of Boston, on the _____ day of _____, 1892.

SECTION 1. The department of public health is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with other organizations for the purpose of procuring and distributing such books and pamphlets as the department of public health may deem it proper to distribute or send gratis without charge, or for a small fee, on the terms, subject to other laws, in such quantities as shall be determined by the board of health in each year. Such agreements may provide for the purchase of books or pamphlets by such organizations during the year of such purchase. It appears that when the books or pamphlets are in the course of preparation or ready for distribution, the board of health may purchase such books or pamphlets in advance of their publication.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
