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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

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AN ACT MAKING PROVISION FOR CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE METHOD  
OF CANCELING STAMPS ON DEEDS AND OTHER INSTRUMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The last sentence of section 2 of chapter 64D of  
2 the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 710 of  
3 the acts of 1951, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3  
4 and 4, the words "cut or perforate the stamp in a substantial  
5 manner, so" and inserting in place thereof the words: — cancel  
6 the stamp in such a manner.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
