The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COMMONWEALTH REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR PART OF THE COST OF OPERATING NURSING SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 74 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 9, as most recently amended by section 6 of
3 chapter 599 of the acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section: —

5 *Section 9.* The commonwealth shall annually pay one half
6 the net maintenance sum to towns, or regional school districts,
7 maintaining approved local or district or regional school dis-
8 trict independent distributive occupations, industrial, agricul-
9 tural, household arts or practical nurse training schools, except
10 agricultural departments in high schools. **The commonwealth**
11 **shall annually pay to cities and towns maintaining nurs-**
12 **ing schools in municipally owned and operated hospitals,**
13 **one half the net maintenance cost of the operation of**
14 **said nursing schools.**
