AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO REPLACE THE PRESENT BRIDGE OVER THE BOSTON AND ALBANY RAILROAD TRACKS ON THE NORTHSIDE TURNPIKE IN THE TOWN OF CHARLTON WITH A NEW STRUCTURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to replace the present bridge over the Boston and
3 Albany railroad tracks on the Northside turnpike in the town of
4 Charlton with a new structure. For said purpose, said depart-
5 ment may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
