By Mr. Kaplan of Brookline, petition of Sumner Z. Kaplan that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles be directed to issue special motor vehicle registration plates to holders of valid amateur radio station licenses. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES TO HOLDERS OF VALID AMATEUR RADIO STATION LICENSES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to provide speedy identification of
3 radio operators during a civil defense emergency, therefore it is
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the im-
5 mediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 6B the following section:—

3 *Section 6C.* The registrar shall, upon application, issue special
4 registration plates to owners of private passenger motor vehicles,
5 who are holders of amateur radio station licenses. Said plates
6 shall contain the official call letters and numbers of such radio
7 stations as are assigned by the Federal Communications Com-
8 mission. Each application shall be accompanied by proof satis-
9 factory to the registrar that the applicant currently holds such
10 a license. An annual fee of twenty-five dollars shall be charged
11 in addition to the regular registration fee.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
