**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL UNPAID COMMISSION OF MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE RATES AND PREMIUMS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president  
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be  
4 designated by the speaker thereof, and two members, who shall  
5 be mayors of cities in the commonwealth, to be appointed by  
6 the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of conducting  
7 an investigation and study of motor vehicle insurance rates and  
8 premiums in the commonwealth. Said commission shall be pro-  
9 vided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, shall hold  
10 hearings and may require by summons the attendance and testi-  
11 mony of witnesses, and the production of any books, documents  
12 and records relating to matters under investigation. Said com-  
13 mission may expend for legal, accounting, clerical and other serv-  
14 ices and expenses such sums, not exceeding one hundred thou-  
15 sand dollars, as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission  
16 shall report to the general court the results of its investigation  
17 and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts  
18 of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into  
19 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or be-  
20 fore the fourth Wednesday of December in the current year.
