AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH AND PROVIDING THAT HE SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO HIS JUDICIAL DUTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 77A of chapter  
2 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the  
3 line reading "second district court of Plymouth," inserted by  
4 section 1 of chapter 586 of the acts of 1959, the following line: —  
5 third district court of Plymouth.

1 SECTION 2. Section 78 of said chapter 218, as appearing in  
2 section 2 of chapter 675 of the acts of 1958, is hereby amended  
3 by striking out line 21 reading, "third district court of  
4 Plymouth,".
