AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR ACCEPTANCE OF AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HARWICH TO RECEIVE AND ADMINISTER THE PROPERTY OF THE ISLAND POND CEMETERY IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 216 of the acts of 1961 is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following sec-
3 tion:—

4 *Section 4.* This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance
5 by a majority of the voters of the town of Harwich present and
6 voting thereon, at an annual or special town meeting called for
7 the purpose and held during the years nineteen hundred and
8 sixty-two or nineteen hundred and sixty-three, but not otherwise.
