AN ACT REORGANIZING THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1947 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the first three sentences, as most recently
3 amended by section 1 of chapter 197 of the acts of 1953, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following:—The affairs of the
5 authority shall be managed by a board of five trustees, appointed
6 by the governor with the advice and consent of the council, of
7 whom one shall be experienced in the transportation field, one in
8 labor relations, and one in administrative and financial matters.
9 Three of the trustees initially appointed hereunder shall serve
10 for a term of two years, and two for a term of one year, respec-
11 tively, as the governor shall provide in their respective appoint-
12 ments. As the term of the trustees expire, his successor shall be
13 appointed by the governor, with like advice and consent, for a
14 term of two years.
