AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SUDBURY TO INCREASE THE PENSION OF AUGUSTUS V. SHARKEY OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good,
2 the town of Sudbury is hereby authorized to pay a pension of
3 fifteen hundred dollars per annum to Augustus V. Sharkey,
4 formerly a police officer of said town, which amount shall be
5 in addition to the pension of seven hundred twenty-six dollars
6 and forty-eight cents, and the annuity of one hundred twenty-
7 six dollars and sixty cents now being paid to the said Augustus
8 V. Sharkey as retirement allowance.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
