## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP ON THE STATE COUNCIL FOR THE AGING AND ON LOCAL COUNCILS FOR THE AGING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 73 of chapter 6 of the General Laws,  
2 as amended by chapter 591 of the acts of 1955, is hereby further  
3 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following  
4 sentence: — No person shall be appointed as a member unless  
5 he is sixty-five years of age, or over.

1 SECTION 2. Section 8B of chapter 40 of the General Laws,  
2 as amended by section 1 of chapter 406 of the acts of 1957,  
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence  
4 the following sentence: — No member of said council shall be  
5 under sixty-five years of age.
