## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ANNUAL AUDIT OF THE ACCOUNTS OF EVERY PUBLIC AUTHORITY CREATED BY THE GENERAL COURT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE AUDITOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any General or Special  
2 Law to the contrary, every public authority created by the  
3 general court shall make an annual report of its activities for the  
4 preceding fiscal year to the governor and the general court. Each  
5 such report shall set forth a complete operating and financial  
6 statement covering its operation during the year. Every such  
7 authority shall cause an audit of its books and accounts to be  
8 made at least once in each fiscal year by the department of the  
9 state auditor and the cost thereof shall be treated as an item of  
10 current expenses. Such audits shall be deemed to be public  
11 records within the meaning of chapter sixty-six of the General  
12 Laws.
