The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION IN THE OFFICIAL BALLOT TO BE USED IN THE TOWN ELECTION OF ALL SUBJECTS REQUESTED BY PETITION SIGNED BY ONE PER CENT OF THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF A TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 39 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
- 2 ing after section 10 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 10A.* **All subjects requested by petition signed**
- 4 **by one per cent of the registered voters of a town, shall**
- 5 **be inserted by the selectmen in the official ballot to be**
- 6 **used at a town election.**

THE COMMUNITARIAN ACT
