## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO HOLD HEARINGS AT NIGHT UPON PETITION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4A of chapter 25 of the General Laws, as amended  
2 by chapter 327 of the acts of 1953, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding at the end the following sentence:— Upon petition,  
4 said hearing shall be held at night.
