
By Mr. Brox of Dracut (by request), petition of Arthur A. Willette and others relative to providing life tenure for the present incumbents of the offices of supervisor of custodians and custodians of the public schools of the town of Dracut. Towns.

AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR THE PRESENT INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF SUPERVISOR OF CUSTODIANS AND THE PRESENT INCUMBENTS OF THE OFFICE OF CUSTODIANS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE TOWN OF DRACUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of the present incumbent of
2 the office of supervisor of custodians and the present incumbents
3 of the office of custodians of the public schools of the town of
4 Dracut, shall, upon the effective date of this act be unlimited,
5 but they may be removed therefrom for cause after hearing in
6 the manner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-
7 one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance by
2 said town at its next annual town meeting in the form of the
3 following question which shall be placed on the official ballot
4 to be used for the election of town officers at said meeting:—
5 “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the current year,
6 entitled, ‘An Act providing life tenure for the present incumbent
7 of the office of supervisor of custodians and the present incum-
8 bents of the office of custodians of the public schools of the town
9 of Dracut’, be accepted?” If a majority of votes in answer to
10 said question is in the affirmative, then this act shall thereupon
11 take full effect, but not otherwise.
