AN ACT RELATIVE TO ACTIONS IN DEATH AND INJURIES RESULTING IN DEATH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 229 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 6A, as most recently amended by section 6 of
3 chapter 238 of the acts of 1958, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section:—

5 *Section 6A.* All sums recovered under section one, two, two
6 B or five A shall, if and to the extent that the assets of the estate
7 of the deceased shall be insufficient to satisfy the same, be sub-
8 ject to the charges of administration and funeral expenses of
9 said estate, to all medical and hospital expenses necessitated
10 by the injury which caused the death, to reasonable attorneys'
11 fees and reasonable costs and expenses of suit incurred in such
12 recovery.
