AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MINIMUM RATES FOR HOURS WORKED IN EXCESS OF FORTY HOURS IN A WORK WEEK IN CERTAIN BUSINESSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1A of chapter 151 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out clause (9), as appearing in chapter 431
3 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 clause:— (9) in a business or specified operation of a business
5 which is carried on during a period or accumulated periods not
6 in excess of four months in any year, and an amusement or rec-
7 reational establishment that operates on a seasonal basis.
