AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO PETER H. JOYCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation
2 the town of Weymouth may appropriate and pay to Peter H.
3 Joyce the sum of seven hundred and twenty-one dollars in full
4 settlement of his claim against the town of Weymouth for
5 damages done by employees of said town to his property num-
6 bered two hundred and seventy Middle street in said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by a
2 majority of the town meeting members of said town present and
3 voting thereon at an annual or special town meeting, but not
4 otherwise.
