RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH TO PAY CEASAR OLDONI
A CERTAIN SUM AS COMPENSATION FOR ACCRUED VACATION LEAVE.

1 *Resolved*, That notwithstanding any general or special law
2 to the contrary, for the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
3 tion and in consideration of the long and meritorious service of
4 Ceasar Oldoni, a former employee of the department of public
5 works, there shall be allowed and paid out of the state treas-
6 ury, subject to appropriation, to said Ceasar Oldoni, the sum of
7 six hundred and seventy-one dollars as compensation for ac-
8 crued vacation leave prior to the date of his retirement.
