AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE INSPECTOR OF BUILDINGS IN THE CITY OF NORTH ADAMS TO INSTITUTE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE REMOVAL OF DILAPIDATED OR SUBSTANDARD BUILDINGS IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The inspector of buildings in the city of North
2 Adams is hereby authorized to petition the city council for the
3 removal of any dilapidated or substandard buildings in said
4 city, and the city council may, in the manner provided in sec-
5 tions one and two of chapter one hundred and thirty-nine of
6 the General Laws, order such buildings removed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city council and the mayor of the city of North Adams, sub-
3 ject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
