AN ACT PROVIDING APPOINTMENT OF APPRAISERS BY THE PROBATE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 195 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 6, as most recently amended
3 by section 1 of chapter 213 of the acts of 1930, and inserting
4 in place thereof the following section:—

5 *Section 6.* The property comprised in the inventory shall be
6 appraised by the fiduciary or fiduciaries provided that one or
7 more appraisers may be appointed by the probate court for
8 good cause shown upon petition of a fiduciary or a person inter-
9 ested. Such appraisers shall be sworn to the faithful perform-
10 ance of their duties.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 215 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 48 thereof.
