AN ACT PROHIBITING THE FLUORIDATION OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 171 the following section: —

3 *Section 171A.* Fluoridation of any public water supply at its
4 source, or of any pond, stream or reservoir contributing to the
5 domestic water supply, is prohibited hereby, and any violation
6 of this section shall be punished by a fine of five thousand dollars
7 and/or imprisonment for not more than one year.
