AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIANS TO THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN MEDICINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 13 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 188 of the acts of 1960, is hereby further
3 amended by adding at the end of said section the following sen-
4 tence:— On and after December thirty-first, nineteen hundred
5 and sixty-two, at least one member of said board shall be a
6 qualified osteopathic physician who is a graduate of a school
7 approved by the American Osteopathic Association.
