AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSPORTATION OF MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES IN VEHICLES OWNED BY CITIES OR TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 33B, the following section: —
- 3 *Section 33C.* An employee of a city or town shall not, during
- 4 the course of his employment, be transported in a truck, unless
- 5 he has been provided with a plank, bench or other adequate
- 6 seating facility in said vehicle.
