By Mr. Brett of Quincy, petition of Joseph E. Brett for a limited exemption from taxation of real property of totally disabled veterans of World War I. Taxation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A LIMITED EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION OF REAL PROPERTY OF TOTALLY DISABLED VETERANS OF WORLD WAR I.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause Twenty-second of section 5 of chapter 59 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (i),
3 inserted by chapter 764 of the acts of 1960, the following para-
4 graph:—

5 (j) Persons who served in the armed forces of the United
6 States between April sixth, nineteen hundred and seventeen and
7 November eleventh, nineteen hundred and eighteen or were
8 awarded the World War I Victory Medal and who, at the time
9 of filing an application for exemption under this section, are
10 totally disabled irrespective of the origin of such disability.
