AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PLACING OF THE OFFICE OF SUPERVISOR OF THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF CHICOPEE UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of supervisor of the sanitation depart-
2 ment of the city of Chicopee shall, upon the effective date of this
3 act, be subject to the civil service laws and rules, and the tenure
4 of office of any incumbent thereof shall be unlimited, subject,
5 however, to said laws and rules. The person holding said office
6 on said effective date shall be subjected to a qualifying examina-
7 tion by the division of civil service and, if he passes said examina-
8 tion, shall be certified for said office and deemed to be perma-
9 nently appointed thereto without being required to serve a
10 probationary period; if he fails to pass said examination, he
11 may continue to serve in said office but shall not be subject to
12 said civil service laws and rules.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the mayor and city council of said city, subject to the provisions
3 of its charter, but not otherwise.
