AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY TO ITEMIZE CERTAIN CHARGES MADE IN THE MONTHLY STATEMENTS FURNISHED CUSTOMERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public utilities is hereby authorized and
2 directed to require that the New England Telephone and Tele-
3 graph Company furnish each customer as part of the monthly
4 statement an itemized listing of the charges for any and all
5 auxiliary (optional) service items.
