## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY FILLING OF A VACANCY  
IN THE OFFICE OF MODERATOR BY THE TOWN MEETING MEMBERS  
IN THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 61 of the acts of 1921 is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and in-  
3 serting in place thereof the following sentence: — If a moderator  
4 is absent or a vacancy exists in the office, a moderator pro  
5 tempore may be elected by the town meeting members.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance  
2 by a majority of the town meeting members of said town present  
3 and voting thereon at an annual or special town meeting, but  
4 not otherwise.
