RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF GEORGE GENTUSO, A MINOR.

1 *Resolved*, That in order to discharge a moral obligation of the
2 commonwealth there shall be allowed and paid out of the state
3 treasury to Annabelle Flammia, as mother and next friend of
4 George Gentuso, a minor, both of Middleton, the sum of five
5 thousand four hundred eighty-nine dollars and eighty-one cents,
6 being the amount of a judgment received by the said Annabelle
7 Flammia, as mother and next friend of George Gentuso, a minor,
8 against Parker Gifford of Danvers, supervisor of the Harold
9 Parker state forest, on account of a dangerous condition created
10 by the said Harold Parker in said state forest resulting in perma-
11 nent injuries to the minor, George Gentuso.
