## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AGE REQUIREMENTS OF PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR CERTIFICATION AS CORRECTION OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 125 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing out section 4, as most recently amended by section 1 of  
3 chapter 50 of the acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following section:—

5 *Section 4.* In certifying the names of male persons eligible  
6 for appointment as correction officers in the said institutions,  
7 the director of civil service shall certify the names of persons  
8 who at the time of examination were over the age of twenty-  
9 two and under the age of thirty-five.
