AN ACT PROVIDING PERMANENT STATUS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, any temporary employee of the city of Cambridge upon
3 the effective date of this act who has served as such for more
4 than one year in a position subject to civil service laws shall be
5 deemed to be permanently appointed to such position. This act
6 shall not apply to employees of the school department of said
7 city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city council of the city of Cambridge.
