AN ACT RELATIVE TO LANDSCAPE GARDENERS AND THEIR EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The present section 1A of chapter 151 of the General Laws
- 2 shall be amended by adding at the end the following:—
- 3 (18) as a landscape gardener or such gardener's helper.
