AN ACT TO PROTECT EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES HAVING HARMONIOUS LABOR RELATIONS FROM PICKETING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (e) of section 20C of chapter 149, as amended by
2 chapter 452 of the acts of 1950, is hereby further amended by
3 adding after the word "award" at the end of paragraph (5) the
4 following paragraph:—

5 (6) That an employer recognize a union where no labor dis-
6 pute or labor trouble exists between said employer and his em-
7 ployees.
