By Mr. Lawton of Brockton, petition of James R. Lawton for legislation to provide that persons authorized by attorneys at law may make certain investigations without being licensed as private detectives. Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A PERSON AUTHORIZED BY AN ATTORNEY AT LAW MAY MAKE CERTAIN INVESTIGATIONS WITHOUT BEING LICENSED AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 23 of chapter 147 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in section 1 of chapter 802 of the acts of 1960, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after subsection (9) the following subsection:—
- 4 (10) A person authorized by an attorney at law to make an
- 5 investigation for the purpose of obtaining information relative
- 6 to a civil action in which such attorney has been retained in the
- 7 course of his profession.
