## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ALLOCATION IN THE GENERAL SALARY SCHEDULE OF THE POSITIONS OF SENIOR CLERK-INTERVIEWER, PRINCIPAL INTERVIEWER AND HEAD INTERVIEWER TO CORRECT CERTAIN INEQUITIES IN THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or rule to the  
2 contrary, the director of personnel and standardization is hereby  
3 authorized and required to change the existing allocation in the  
4 general salary schedule, as recently amended by chapter seven  
5 hundred and eighty-two, section two, of the acts of nineteen  
6 hundred and sixty, of senior clerk-interviewer, division of em-  
7 ployment security, from group 8 to group 10; principal inter-  
8 viewer in such division from group 10 to group 12, and head  
9 interviewer in such division from group 11 to group 13. Not-  
10 ing herein shall be construed to impair the promotional rights of  
11 employees subordinate to the positions enumerated above. No  
12 state funds are involved. The division of personnel and stand-  
13 ardization shall be instructed to make these changes upon the  
14 passage of this act.
