## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF UNUSED SICK LEAVE ALLOWANCE TO RETIRING OR DECEASED EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 31A of chapter 29, as most recently amended, is hereby  
2 further amended by adding the following new subsection (d):—  
3 (d) Upon the death or retirement of a member of the retire-  
4 ment system, as defined in section one of chapter thirty-two,  
5 and who has remaining “unused” sick leave under the rules  
6 and regulations promulgated by the director of personnel and  
7 standardization under section twenty-eight of chapter seven,  
8 as amended, payment of unused sick leave credits shall be made  
9 at the rate of one day of salary for each four days of “unused  
10 sick leave”; said salary to be paid at the rate of salary effective  
11 on the last working day immediately preceding retirement.  
12 Payments under this subsection shall be made in the same  
13 manner as prescribed in subsection (a) of this section.
