AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE EXCISE TAX UPON CHARGES FOR MEALS
SERVED TO THE PUBLIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter sixty-four B of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
