By Mr. Kerr of Belmont, petition of Edward L. Kerr that provision be made for life tenure for Howard C. Kramer, incumbent of the office of manager of the light department of the town of Belmont. Towns.

AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR HOWARD C. KRAMER, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF MANAGER OF THE LIGHT DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF BELMONT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of the office of Howard C. Kramer,
2 incumbent of the office of manager of the light department of
3 the town of Belmont, shall, upon the effective date of this act,
4 be unlimited. Said incumbent shall not be removed from office
5 except for just cause and for reasons specifically given him in
6 writing by the board of selectmen in the manner provided by
7 section forty-three of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance
2 by the town of Belmont by a majority of the town meeting mem-
3 bers present and voting thereon at the annual town meeting in
4 the year nineteen hundred and sixty-two, but not otherwise.
