AN ACT REGULATING THE RATES OF FARE TO BE CHARGED STUDENTS ATTENDING ANY COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY OR OTHER INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 160 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Ter-
2 centenary Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section
3 108, the following new section:—

4 *Section 108A.* The rates of fare charged by street or elevated
5 railway companies for the transportation of students attending
6 any college, university or other institution of higher learning,
7 between a given point from or to which it is necessary for them
8 to ride in traveling to and from such educational institution
9 which they are attending, whether such educational institution is
10 located in the city or town where the student resides or in an-
11 other city or town, shall not exceed twenty cents each way.
12 Tickets for the transportation of students as aforesaid shall be
13 sold by said companies in lots of at least ten each.
