By Mr. Patrone of Boston, petition of Charles L. Patrone for legislation to increase the radius for the weighing of overloaded vehicles. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT INCREASING THE RADIUS FOR THE WEIGHING OF OVERLOADED VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 19A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended
2 is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence in
3 the second paragraph of said section and substituting therefor
4 the following sentence:—Every operator of a motor vehicle
5 operated on a way shall, upon request or direction of any officer
6 authorized to enforce the provisions of this chapter, operate
7 such motor vehicle with any trailer which may be attached
8 thereto to and upon the nearest scales within a distance of not
9 more than six miles and permit the weighing thereof together
10 with its load.
