By Mr. Kenneally of Boston, petition of George V. Kenneally, Jr., that the Metropolitan District Commission be directed to construct an artificial ice-skating rink at Morrissey Boulevard in the Dorchester district of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ARTIFICIAL ICE-SKATING RINK ON THE LAND BELONGING TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION BOUNDED BY VICTORY ROAD, FREEPORT STREET AND MORRISSEY BOULEVARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to acquire and construct an artificial ice-skating
3 rink on the land bounded by Victory road, Freeport street ex-
4 tension, and Morrissey boulevard in the Dorchester section of
5 Boston. For said purpose said commission may expend such
6 sums as may be appropriated therefor.
