

HOUSE No. 1614

By Mr. Langone of Boston, petition of Joseph A. Langone, 3rd, for legislation to provide that the Attorney General shall supervise all actions and claims against the Metropolitan Transit Authority. Metropolitan Affairs.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALL ACTIONS AND CLAIMS AGAINST THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY BE HANDLED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1947 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the fourth paragraph and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 The attorney general of the commonwealth shall have charge
5 of and supervise the investigation, settlement and defense of
6 all such claims and of all other suits or actions relating to the
7 property, or arising out of the construction, maintenance or
8 operation of the transportation system.
