AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT FEDERAL GRANTS FOR OR IN AID OF CERTAIN PLANNING, STUDIES AND ESTIMATES OF COST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1947 is
2 hereby further amended by adding at the end the following
3 sentence: — In carrying out these duties the trustees may apply
4 for, receive, and accept from any federal agency grants for or
5 in aid of the planning, studies and estimates of cost authorized
6 by this section.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
