AN ACT EXEMPTING THE PLYMOUTH COUNTY HOSPITAL FROM THE REORGANIZATION OF TUBERCULOSIS HOSPITALS IN THE COMMONWEALTH FOR AN ADDITIONAL FIVE YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 14 of chapter 608 of the acts of 1961 is hereby amended
- 2 by adding at the end the following sentence: — The provisions
- 3 of this section shall not apply to the Plymouth County Hospital
- 4 until January first, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
