AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE OF THE QUESTION OF CONTINUING THE FLUORIDATION OF THE DOMESTIC WATER SUPPLY OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the  
2 following question shall be printed on the official ballot to be  
3 used in the city of Cambridge in the biennial state election to  
4 be held in the current year: — “Shall the fluoridation  
5 of the domestic water supply of the city of Cam-  
6 bridge be continued?”
