AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ALLOCATION IN THE GENERAL SALARY SCHEDULE OF CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY TO CORRECT CERTAIN INEQUITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or rule to the con-
2 trary, the director of personnel and standardization is hereby
3 authorized and required to change the existing allocation in the
4 general salary schedule as recently amended by chapter seven
5 hundred and eighty two, section two, of the acts of nineteen
6 hundred and sixty, of employment service supervisor from group
7 16 to group 17, personnel supervisor division of employment
8 security, from group 16 to group 17, supervisor of benefits di-
9 vision of employment security, from group 16 to group 17,
10 supervisor business management division of employment se-
11 curity from group 16 to group 17, supervisor information divi-
12 sion of employment security, from group 16 to group 17, super-
13 visor methods division of employment security, from group 15
14 to group 17, supervisor property management division of em-
15 ployment security, from group 15 to group 17, supervisor research
16 and statistics division of employment security, from group 16 to
17 group 17, supervisor training division of employment security,
18 from group 16 to group 17. Nothing herein shall be construed
19 to impair the promotional rights of employees subordinate to the
20 positions enumerated above. No state funds are involved. The
21 division of personnel and standardization shall be instructed to
22 make these changes upon the passage of this act.
