## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY AND ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE NORFOLK DISTRICT AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF TWO ADDITIONAL DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND ESTABLISHING THEIR SALARIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 12 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the sixth paragraph, as appear-  
3 ing in section 2 of chapter 423 of the acts of 1948, and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 For the Norfolk district, an assistant district attorney, a  
6 second assistant district attorney, a third assistant district at-  
7 torney, a fourth assistant district attorney and a fifth assistant  
8 district attorney.

1 SECTION 2. Section 15 of said chapter 12 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the sixth paragraph, as appearing in section 1 of  
3 chapter 684 of the acts of 1956, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following paragraph:—

5 For the Norfolk district, twelve thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 3. Section 16 of said chapter 12 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the sixth paragraph, as appearing in section 1  
3 of chapter 686 of the acts of 1956, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following paragraph:—

5 For the Norfolk district, assistant, seven thousand five hun-  
6 dred dollars; second assistant, six thousand dollars; third as-  
7 sistant, five thousand dollars; fourth assistant, four thousand  
8 dollars; and fifth assistant, four thousand dollars.
